ORDINANCE NO. 570

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §145-30 B; § 145-33; §145-35; AND §145-48 A
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF LIGONIER
CONCERNING PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Ligonier in session lawfully assembled as follows:

SECTION I

The following designated paragraphs and subparagraphs of §145-30 B of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Ligonier are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 145-30 (B) Charges.

(1) Each parking meter shall be so set as to display a signal showing legal parking upon the deposit of the following amounts for the following times and upon operation of said meter:

(a) The meter rates for vehicles parking in the municipal parking lots located on North Market Street, Pine Alley and South Market Street shall be \$0.25 for each 30 minute time period.

(b) All other metered parking locations in the Borough of Ligonier shall have meter rates as follows:

[1] Free for the initial 15 minutes time period when meter is operated to register said free time period.

[2] \$0.25 for each 30 minute time period thereafter.

- (c) The monthly parking rates for parking permits in the municipal parking lots are established as follows:
- (1) \$55 per month for the North Market and Church Street lot designated as Lot A
 - (2) \$45 per month for the Pine Alley parking lot designated as Lot C
 - (3) \$35 per month for the South Market Street lot designated as Lot B
 - (4) The Borough Council shall establish by rules and regulations the number and location of permit parking spaces in each lot and the days and hours during which the parking permits are valid.
 - (5) Paragraph (5) is deleted.
- (d) The monthly parking rates for a metered street parking permit restricted only to a Ligonier Borough resident who has no off-street parking at his or her residence are as follows:
- (1) \$35 per month with a 10% discount if paid one year in advance
 - (2) \$25 per month for a Ligonier Borough resident over the age of 70 years with a 10% discount if paid one year in advance

SECTION II

All other paragraphs, subparagraphs and provisions of § 145-30 B shall remain in effect and unchanged.

SECTION III

The following sentence is added to § 145.33 titled "Manner of parking at meter":

Any vehicle parked in any municipal parking lot space or in any parking space surrounding the Diamond shall be parked "HEAD IN ONLY" with the front of the vehicle facing the parking meter.

SECTION IV

§145-35 of the Code of Ordinances titled “Days and hours of operation” is hereby amended to read as follows:

With the exception of the parking meters in the municipal parking lots, each parking meter shall be in operation and the provisions to this Article regulating such operation shall be in force between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays and Saturdays with the exception of legal holidays set forth herein. Each parking meter in the municipal parking lots shall be in operation 24 hours daily, excluding the time between 12:00 midnight Saturday and 12:00 midnight Sunday with the exception of the legal holidays set forth herein. The legal holidays applicable in this section are New Year’s Day, Martin Luther King Day, President’s Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans’ Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

SECTION V

§145-48 A of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person violating any of the provisions of Articles IV and V, with the exception of §145-34, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300.00 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than 30 days and to have his or her vehicle impounded, provided that payment of the amount of the fine or fines set forth in the notice to the Office of the Mayor (see Subsection C below) or deposit of the same amount in the courtesy box, within the time limit and under the circumstances provided by §145-36 of this chapter, shall save from prosecution any person making such payments.

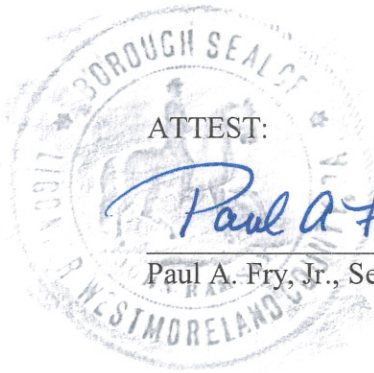
SECTION VI

All other Sections, paragraphs, subparagraphs and provisions of Chapter 145 shall remain in effect and unchanged.

SECTION VII

This ordinance shall become effective on JANUARY 1, 2018.
